Underneath, a brass plate with the words "Wolrd Voyage 1992 YOUNG ENDEAVOUR AUSTRALIA". Although Young Endeavour is mainly used to provide sail training to Australian youth, it is operated by the Royal Australian Navy .The badge was given as a gift to celebrate the Austraiia's bicentenary to the young endeavour to the people of Australia by the British goverment.
