### Description

The Hr.Ms. Willem van der Zaan (N 82, F 824, A 880) was a Dutch minelayer, built by the Amsterdam shipyard Nederlandsche Dok Maatschappij. The ship was named after the 17th century Rear Admiral Willem van der Zaan. The badge shows a field blue, an Argent rampant horse, topped with a naval crown and two half anchors on each side.
